This will be a day of healthy conversations about the border and how we interpret who we are as the body of Christ.

The multiple political, humanitarian, and legal issues around the border are complex and not always easy to understand within the context of our faith. Fuente De Vida @ the Border offers participants a day to explore these issues from a faith perspective while building relationships with other Disciples and humanitarian workers and those with whom they accompany in Nogales, Sonora.
